

RE: Expansion of Animal Shelter

I have attached a quote from TriStar Metals for four banks of double stack isolation style cages. The estimated cost for these new cages is \$14,114.40. The Springdale Animal Shelter Foundation has recently received a generous donation to renovate the room next to my office. This donation will cover the cost of new flooring, drainage, access to water, new ventilation, new lighting, and a store front window to be installed.

With the addition of new cages, this room will become a much needed, isolated, and clean area for very young dogs to reside while in our care. The new cages, in combination with the store front window, will allow visitors to the shelter to view these puppies without being able to interact with them. This will help to quell the risk of cross contamination of these dogs by well-intentioned guests at our facility, allowing us to adopt out healthier animals to new families.

Based on discussions in previous meetings regarding improvements to the animal shelter I would like to place this funding request on the next available CIP Committee agenda.

Mayor Sprouse,

As directed by the Street & CIP Committee members at last night's committee meeting I have completed the cost estimate to extend Paradise Lane north 340 feet from the end of the existing pavement to the end of the shared private drive. There are two options for consideration as follows:

1. Pave the existing private drive which is currently 12-foot wide. This would require 150 tons of Class 7 base stone and 50 tons of Type 2 hot mix asphalt. Cost for the base is \$1,283 and the cost of the HMA is \$2,892. Total Cost \$4,175.
2. Extend the existing 20-foot wide roadway. This would require removal of the existing tree line shown in the attached aerial photo. Cost to remove the trees including the root balls would be approximately \$5,000. Extending the roadway at a width of 20-foot would require 251 tons of Class 7 base stone and 83 tons of HMA for a total cost including removal of the trees of \$11,950.

Since there are only four (4) homes to be served by paving the private drive the cost per resident would be as follows:

Option 1	\$1,043.75 per home.
Option 2	\$2,987.50 per home.



This letter is in reference to possibly acquiring some items for the Crisis Negotiator Team and the Incident Command Vehicle. I have attached with this letter information for each item.

I would like to request the purchase of an awning for the incident command vehicle. The awning would not only be for shade but to get out of the weather when the inside of the vehicle is being used for other vital functions. There have been incidents in the past that an awning would have been very handy for you as the incident commander and other personnel to stay with the vehicle but weather did not permit this. I had received a quote from McGaugh RV on Wagon Wheel for a 9 foot, motorized awning about a year and a half ago which I am hoping would still apply. They quoted me \$1492.00 for the awning and all necessary parts for installation. Looking on-line, this seems to be a very good deal. If this awning were to be ordered directly from the company, the price of the awning itself was around \$1600. That did not include additional parts and shipping. McGaugh advised that it would cost more to install it but they also advised that our mechanics could install it just the same.

The second item I am proposing is a small color printer for the command vehicle. The printer would be used to print out suspect photos and information in real time instead of having to wait for it being relayed from the station. Often times during the intelligence gathering portion of crisis negotiations, things get delayed because information is not getting relayed quickly enough. The reason for the color component is so that the SWAT team especially the snipers have a color photo of the suspect. It has been relayed to me that currently they have suspect photos sent to them via their smart phones. This causes potential officer safety issues due to light coming from their phones. The one that I am proposing that would work for our needs is about \$35.

The third item I am requesting is a mini projector for the incident command function. We would be able to project map images on the inside of the truck or on a pull down screen on the outside to help in coordination of manpower or search and rescue functions. The mini projector I am proposing fits in the palm of your hand and is easily portable. It also has enough light output that images would be visible in daylight conditions. Potentially the projector could be used as a medium to view live video from the inside of a school or many other different functions. The projector that I have found that would be the best for our needs is about \$299.

Lastly, I would like to be able to purchase long and short sleeve t-shirts for the team. We have found that due to our SOP of having a call out vest or ballistic vest on when we are at a scene, the identifiers that we are negotiators become covered. I have included a shirt design that would readily identify us and still give us a professional appearance during training with other agencies or at classes and conferences. The shirts range from \$16 to \$19 a piece. Cost for all of the team members to have the short and long sleeve versions would be around \$400.




