Street Bore Procedures

1. No street bore permit shall be issued without prior approval from the City Street Inspector or a Public Works official. A minimum of (4) four-hour advanced notice is required by the Public Works Department. Only after approval is received will a permit be issued. The permit cost is (\$10.00) ten dollars.
2. A minimum (\$5000.00) five-thousand-dollar surety bond must be posted with the City of Springdale Public Works Department before a permit is issued or commencement of the proposed street bore. A review of the scope of the proposed work may require a surety bond in excess of the minimum and of sufficient amount to cover the cost of all damage that may occur.
3. Work zones must meet the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) regulations must be set up at all street bore location to insure worker and traffic safety.
4. There must be an on-site inspection by the City Street Inspector before a permit can be issued.
5. The minimum depth for a street bore is (30") thirty inches depending on the size of the utility.
6. The City Street Inspector must be notified before any boring is done. No boring shall begin without the presence of the inspector. Normal working hours are from 7:30 AM to 4: 00 PM. Any party needing to make an emergency street bore after these hours **must call** cell phone # 479-601-4273 for the City Street Inspector. A (\$30.00) thirty dollar per hour charge will be assessed to all after hour call outs, in addition to the normal charges.
7. Bore pits must be left open until the final inspection is completed by the Street inspector.
8. The party making the bore shall be responsible for the cost of any repairs to the City Street if any damage should occur during the boring process and for the future repairs due to settling of the street caused by the boring, if it should occur.
9. The surety bond shall be returned to the applicant after (90) days and the permanent repair is completed and the City has received payment for the repair.
10. This Permit does not allow for any open cutting of the street.
