Riparian [ri-pair-ee-uhn]

A riparian buffer is the area of land next to a creek, stream, or river, also known as the streambanks and floodplain area. In nature, riparian buffers can include trees, shrubs, grasses, and flowers.

Riparian buffers are important for water quality, but also:

- Decrease streambank erosion
- Filter sediments and pollutants
- Provide stormwater storage
- Increase wildlife habitat
- Provide cooler water and air temperatures
- Increase groundwater infiltration
