Rescue Daily Check Form Explanations

EXTERIOR	
Audible Warning Devices	physical damage
Back-Up Alarm/Lights	proper operation, physical damage on lights, lenses clean
Doors/Windows	physical damage, windows clean
Emergency Lights	operational, physical damage, lenses clean
Headlights	operational, high/low beams, physical damage, adjusted properly
Marker/Tail/Brake/Scene Lights	operational (including turn signals & flashers), physical damage, lenses clean
Mirrors	physical damage, proper adjustment, lenses clean
Tires/Wheels	proper inflation, tread depth, uneven wear, physical damage, wheel covers secure & undamaged, proper hub oil level, leakage
Transmission Fluid	fluid within proper limits on dipstick
Undercarriage/Suspension	visually inspect for fluid leaks, physical damage, audible air leaks
Vehicle Body	leaning to one side, visible rust, physical damage to body/paint/decals/gold leaf
Winch	properly secured, physical damage, controls present (in cab), operational
Windshield Wipers/Washers	wipers securely attached and properly tensioned against window, physical damage, condition of rubber, fluid reservoir full
ENGINE COMPARTMENT	
Coolant	within proper limits in reservoir/radiator full
Cooling Fan	physical damage, loose fasteners/bearings
Drive Belts	physical damage, proper tension
Engine Oil	within proper limits on dipstick
Hoses	physical damage/condition, leaks
Overview	physical damage, fluid leaks, visibly loose fasteners/components, audible air leaks
Power Steering Fluid	within proper limits on dipstick
CAB INTERIOR	
AED	physical damage, display showing "OK", patches present/undamaged
Brakes	hold vehicle in place with engine idling and transmission in drive (remain in cab), audible air leaks/falling air pressure on gauge
CO Monitor	powers up, proper operation, physical damage
Doors/Windows	open/close properly, latches, cranks & locks operate properly, physical damage
FDC Wrench	present/undamaged
Flashlights/Chargers	proper operation, physical damage
Fuel Card	present and undamaged
Fuel Level	gauge shows above 1/2 tank at minimum
Gauges	operational, readings within normal ranges, dash lights operational
Interior Lights	physical damage, operational
Inventory	map books, ERG, binoculars, exam gloves, safety vests, smoke detectors, test smoke, clipboard, etc are present
Knox Key	key secured in locking device, key & device undamaged, key securing device powers up
Overview of Cab Interior	physical damage, audible air leaks, cleanliness, missing equipment, audible air leaks
Paperwork	CO Investigation Forms, False Alarm Reports, Patient Release Forms, proof of vehicle insurance, city accident report form
Parking Brake	holds vehicle in place with engine idling and transmission in drive (remain in cab during this check)
Radios	radios present, operational, set to proper channel, battery charged, spare batteries present/charged & undamaged
Seats/Seatbelts	physical damage, adjusted properly, operating properly
Sirens/Horns	operational
Steering Wheel	physical damage, securely mounted, excessive free play
Voice Amplifiers	all present, physical damage, operational
COMPARTMENTS	
Cascade System	physical damage, cylinders secure, cylinders at 4500 psi
Compartment Lights	operational, physical damage
Drinking Water	physical condition of container, refill with ice water, sufficient cups available
Fire Extinguishers	fully charged, physical damage, pin is in place & secured
Hydraulic Equipment/Tools	physical damage, properly stored, fluid levels within proper limits, obvious leaks
Inventory of Compartments	all normally carried equipment present/properly stowed, physical damage
Life Vests/Rope Bags	all equipment present & properly stowed, physical damage
Medical Bag	physical damage, inventory, equipment condition & operation
Oil Dry	containers full, physical condition of containers
PPV/Saws	physical damage, chain/blades installed properly, fuel tanks full
Rescue 42 Equipment	all equipment present/stowed properly, physical damage
SCBA	physical damage, full cylinder, electronics operating properly, regulator controls set properly, spare masks present/undamaged
Wheel Chocks	present, physical damage/condition

Discrepancies and/or missing items should be rectified as soon as possible. When indicated, the appropriate Firehouse entry shall be completed regarding the discrepancy/missing item.
