

Bluff Cemetery Floral Regulations

- Funeral flowers, holders, containers, baskets and easels will be removed after the fifth day of the funeral service.
- All wreaths, easels, baskets and potted plants are to be placed as close to head stone as possible to allow for mowing and maintenance.
- Glass containers, tin cans, and breakable plastic containers are not permitted at any time.
- Statues, ceramic, glass, cement, porcelain, plastic or metal figurines can be placed on monuments, but not on the ground.
- No planting of live flowers, shrubs or trees will be permitted (unless expressed written consent is granted) at anytime except by cemetery maintenance personnel.
- Live cut flowers in attached permanent vases are permitted at anytime.
- Artificial flowers pertinent to the season and in attached permanent vases are permitted at anytime.
- Artificial flowers placed in the ground near the head stone will be permitted, but can and will be removed by cemetery personnel as needed to properly mow and maintain the cemetery.
- Special holiday arrangements placed on and around head stones as well as in permanent vases in the months of November and December that are considered to be of a seasonal nature will be left on the graves until February 28. They will then be removed and discarded.

- Memorial Day arrangements and wreaths that are not securely attached to head stones or in permanent vases will be removed after June 30, or as necessary, to allow for mowing and maintenance.
- Arrangements for other holidays not in keeping with our floral regulations can be removed at the time of the first mowing after the holiday.
- Any floral arrangements will be removed when they become discolored, wilted, seasonally inappropriate or unsightly in any manner.
- No person shall remove any plant or flower that is actively growing in the cemetery at any time.
